- a. Exhibitors may enter TWO entries per class and must comply with **Agricultural Sciences/Home Economics/Arts General Rules and Regulations (pages 1-3)**.
- b. **All exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor – Garden grown, not greenhouse.**
- c. **Exhibitors in all classes MUST furnish their own clear, transparent jar or bottle for exhibition (no plastic cartons or plastic pop bottles will be accepted). Containers will not be judged. NO COLORED GLASS.** Exhibitors will be responsible for picking up their own exhibition jars or bottles. They will NOT be grouped by exhibitor names.
- d. **No Substitutions will be allowed in this Department.**
- e. **All exhibits must be in containers and ready to be exhibited upon arrival or they will not be accepted.**
- f. All entries must be cleaned and groomed for judging. Foliage should remain on stems. Remove foliage that is below the water line in containers. Remove any dead flowers from exhibits. **Stems should be cut as long as possible.**
- g. Judging will be done on **Wednesday** evening of fair week. Entries must remain in place until 5:00 pm Sunday. **WILTED FLOWERS WILL BE DISPOSED OF BY SUPERINTENDENTS** during the Fair as needed. **All Flowers will be disposed of Sunday evening.**
- h. Exhibitors who have a large number of entries in Dept. L-9 or Dept. LP-60 (Garden Cut Flowers) are asked to allow plenty of time to have exhibits checked in, tags attached, and entries taken to the area for each exhibit.
- i. Only the indicated number of blooms, stems or branches should be exhibited.
- j. Exhibitors not following the stated rules will be disqualified.
- k. Judging criteria will focus on perfection of the bloom(s) plus stems and foliage.
- l. **Champion Awards – See Rule 17, Page 3.**

2379	4379	Other Annual – any other annual not listed above-3 stems, same color, same variety. Write name of plant on entry tag.
2380	4380	Other Perennial – any other perennial not listed above-3 stems, same color, same variety. Write name of plant on entry tag.
2381	4381	Largest Hosta Leaf – largest leaf, measured from base of leaf blade to point, any type; healthiest specimen

HOUSE PLANTS

1. Exhibitors may enter TWO entries per class and must comply with Rules & Regulations (pages 1-3)
2. If known, please write name of plant on exhibitor tag when you bring plant to the Fair.
3. Plants must be established and not recently transplanted.
4. Plants will not be watered after Wednesday evening unless requested.
5. You must provide a tray or saucer under your entry.
6. Stable containers only! Please use lightweight pots - 12" diameter pot or less.
7. Hanging pots MUST be suspended by wire, plastic, or macrame hangers.
8. Maximum 30-inch plant diameter.
9. House plants can be picked up Sunday evening after 5:00 pm, with your claim tag.
