- a. Exhibitors may enter **TWO** entries per class and must comply with **Agricultural Sciences/Home Economics/Arts General Rules and Regulations** (pages 1-3). Plates will be furnished for all **INDIVIDUAL VEGETABLE** entries.
- b. All exhibits **MUST** have been grown during the current year by the **exhibitor** unless specified.
- c. **No Substitutions will be allowed in this Department.**
- d. All vegetables **MUST** be labeled as to variety, i.e. Nantes Carrots.
- e. Vegetables **MUST BE** in their natural state, no waxing permitted.
- f. Judging of individual vegetable entries will be based on optimum marketable quality and size, condition, uniformity, quantity, labeling and arrangement. Entries must be of show and display quality.
- g. **HERBS** – 6 stems, minimum of 5". Tied with string.
ONIONS/RADISH – Dry, not peeled – 2" stem, ½" Root.
- h. Classes will be judged on Wednesday **and must be in place on Wednesday by 6:00 pm** and remain in place until 5:00 pm Sunday.
- i. Vegetable exhibits are **NOT** to be picked up, only special display baskets, display boxes, etc.
- j. Judging of Group Garden, Garden Novelty, & Vegetable Art entries will be based on quality, condition, quantity, uniformity, and labeling. Entry must be of show and display quality.
- k. **FAMILY GARDEN** entries shall consist of at least five (5) different kinds of vegetables grown by the exhibitor during the current year and exhibited in a box appropriate to the size of the collection but no larger than 2'x 3'x 4" deep. The number of individual entries should be the same number as in individual classes.
- l. **Champion Awards – See Rule 17, Page 3.**

4123	Best Tray of Vegetables – On a tray, exhibit any 5 types of vegetables, two of each kind (i.e. 2 potatoes, 2 onions, 2 peppers, etc.) for a total exhibit of 10 items. Vegetables must be of same variety (i.e. Nantes Carrots).
